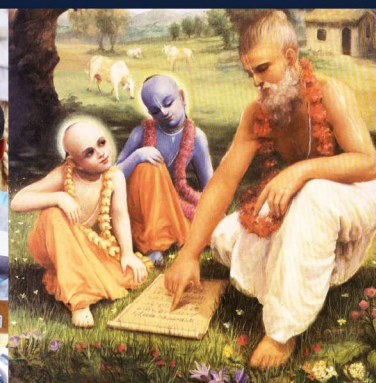
We at Campion welcome students who are motivated to prepare themselves to face future challenges posed by the volatile economy and rapid advancements in science and technology.

With the collaborative effort of staff, students, parents and the Management, Campion ensures that all our academic programmes cater to children and meet the desired academic excellence in students.

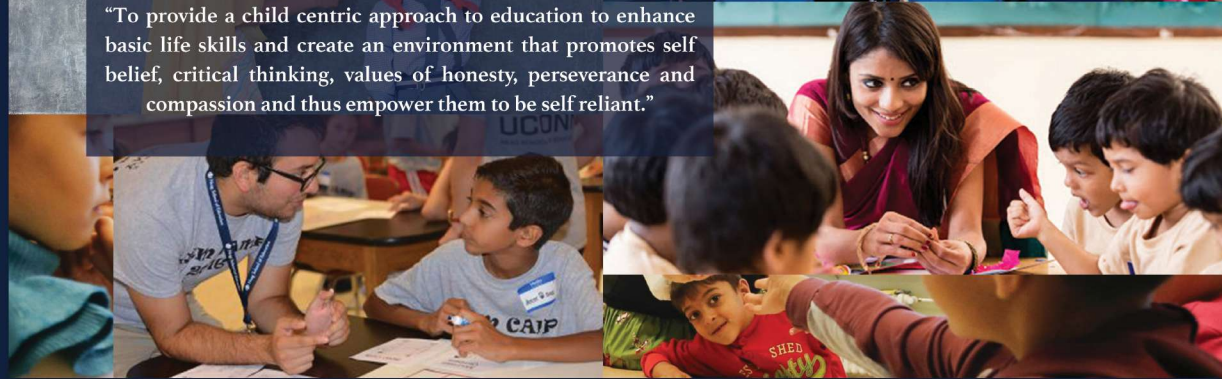
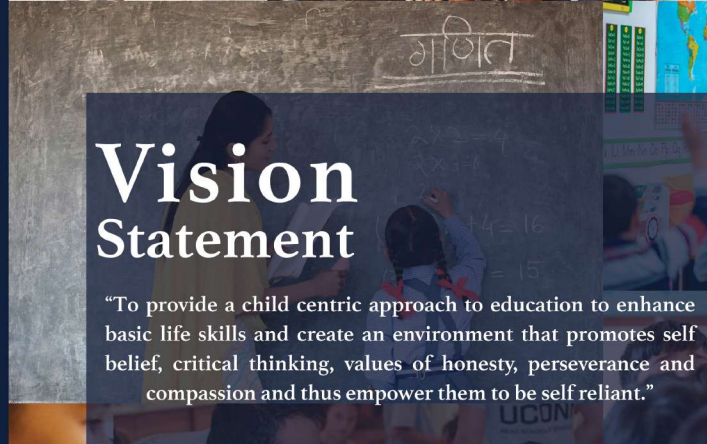

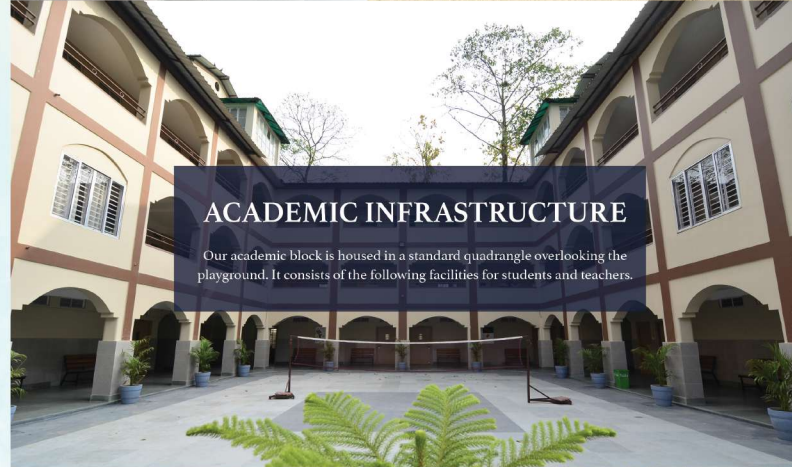

LOCATION

The school is located in a natural surrounding slightly away from the hustle and bustle of the town to provide a serene learning environment. The school is surrounded on one side by a peaceful residential neighbourhood and on the other side by tea gardens overlooking a stream which adds to the beauty of the location. The school is easily accessible from the **NH110** (connecting Siliguri to Darjeeling) and is about a 5 km drive from Siliguri town.



CLASSROOMS

Campion International School provides spacious and well ventilated classrooms to encourage a comfortable learning environment for students. The classrooms are equipped with smart boards and other facilities as per the learning curriculum as required at primary, middle school and secondary levels.



LIBRARY

Campion International School has a very well stocked library with books ranging from academic and curriculum related reference books to novels and classics of a wide range of authors to motivate children to read. CAMPION INTERNATIONAL SCHOOL HOUSES FACILITIES FOR THE FOLLOWING OUTDOOR AND INDOOR SPORTS:

- **FOOTBALL** : Our school boasts of one of the best football teams in town. Our football field is specially cut out to encourage Futsal as the recently popular intense and faster version of five a side football.
- **BASKETBALL** : Campion International School is the host for the Inter School Basketball tournament organised by the North Bengal Basketball Association annually.
- **VOLLEYBALL** : One of the few schools in town to provide facility for volleyball.
- **BADMINTON** : A semi-indoor and out- door badminton courts with adequate lighting.
- **CRICKET** : Adequate gear and facilities for competitive cricket.
- **SWIMMING** : Campion International School is one of the few schools to provide facility for swimming for all students during the summer season. Swimming sessions are organized fortnightly for day scholars and twice a week for hostel students under the supervision of a qualified trainer.
- **Indoor Games**, Chess, Carrom and other board games for leisure develops active and sharp minds.



Campion International School in association with professionals of State and National Levels, conducts regular workshops and camps in order to help students learn and train better in various areas of Co-curricular and Sporting activities.



ART AND CRAFT

Art and Design are firmly embedded in the School's Curriculum. A separate section within the academic block is dedicated to Art and Craft. The Arts Department is equipped to impart training in a wide variety of skills ranging from painting, fine arts and drawing to design and clay modeling also. A dedicated faculty for Art and Craft along with special sessions from visiting faculty for the development of Art and Design for students.

MUSIC

We provide ample opportunity for the students to hone their skills as budding musicians and singers with a separate section within the academic block dedicated to music and singing.

All are encouraged at a very early age to learn instruments of their choice ranging from Guitar, Keyboard and Drums to classical instruments such as Tabla, Harmonium and Flute. Campion International School plans to come up with a separate Music Academy with a sound proof music room and specialists as visiting faculty to train students in Modern, Classical and Folk Music with degrees in music from affiliated institutions like Trinity.



STAGE ACTIVITIES

Campion International School is one of the very few schools in town with an open amphitheatre that provides the perfect atmosphere for students to sharpen their cultural side.

WIDE VARIETY OF CULTURAL AND STAGE ACTIVITIES ARE ENCOURAGED WHICH INCLUDE:

- **DRAMATICS** - Dramatics Club to inculcate creativity and flair for acting and drama
- **DANCING** - Dedicated sessions with professional dance teachers as visiting faculty (Presently associated with Happy Feet Dance & Co.)
- The school provides a platform for the development of the same through Debate Competitions, Elocution Contests, Mock Parliament and Extempore Speech competitions.
- **QUIZ** - The school encourages quizzing to develop general knowledge
- **PUBLIC SPEAKING CLASSES** - Regular classes to build confidence and develop public speaking ability.

MARTIAL ARTS & YOGA

Campion International School provides facility for learning yoga and martial arts (Taekwondo) with separate visiting faculty. We believe that Yoga and Martial Arts are essential in training both the mind and the body

for enhancing concentration, improving physical fitness of a child and preparing them for self defense.

SKILL CLUBS

Campion International School is a home for student club activities to develop co-curricular skills. The clubs include Cookery Club, Craft Club, Literary Club, Nature Club, Integrity Club and Photography Club. There are dedicated time slots for each club activity, guided by efficient teachers.



TOURS AND EXCURSIONS

Campion International School organizes excursions for its students. Participation in these excursions is by choice of parents and students. The nature of the excursions range from short ones like Tea Garden Visits, Wild life Sanctuary Visits, Gorumara, Jaldapara & Mahananda Wild life Sanctuary, Darjeeling or Sikkim to longer ones such as planned holidays out of state and across the country.





LIFE ON THE “CAMPION” CAMPUS

“A Home Away From Home”

Campion Hostel is a well planned modern building with all amenities for perfect living. The Dormitories, Dining Hall, Washrooms, Bathing Rooms and Corridors are all renovated aesthetically to suit students of all ages. We believe in maintaining a healthy and balanced routine for the students to ensure activity, studies and rest at proper times.

- Separate dormitories for Boys and Girls monitored at all times by Hostel Wardens & In-house teachers.
- The Hostel has 24 hours running Hot and Cold Water and facility for Power Backup.
- Each Dormitory is provided with a Washroom and Lavatories for ease and comfort of children.
- A typical day starts with a morning walk and exercise (yoga and sports) followed by classes in school and ends in the evenings with sports, games and supervised study by residential teachers.
- The Hostel Matrons, Wardens and In-House Teachers are present 24 X 7 to look after the welfare and discipline of each and every student.

MEDICARE & ENTERTAINMENT

Utmost importance is given to safety and health of all Boarders. The Hostel is staffed with a trained Matron and a Warden who can provide basic First Aid. A Doctor visits every fortnight and in case of medical emergencies, the Hostel has easy access to doctors and nearby hospitals. Hostel has separate Entertainment halls for Boys and Girls. Boarders can enjoy the facility of television and indoor games (Table Tennis, Carrom, Chess and other Board Games).

OUTINGS

Outings for senior students are provided on fortnightly basis to break from the monotony of the School and Hostel programmes. Outings for juniors are escorted by Hostel Staff at all times. All Boarders are closely monitored for purchases and expenditures made by them.

USE OF MOBILES AND GADGETS

The children are allowed to make calls to their parents/guardians on Wednesdays and Saturdays. In case of emergency, the Warden or Matron will contact the parents. Mobile phones are allowed only with prior permission of School and Hostel authorities.



DINING HALL & KITCHEN

Campion Hostel has a spacious, neat and hygienic kitchen and dining facility offering a well balanced, wholesome and healthy Vegetarian and Non Vegetarian Food, prepared under the guidance of a professional dietician and trained chef. **Campion Hostel has an In-house cook who stays on Campus.** Day Boarders on option are provided with a Mid Day Meal while Boarders enjoy four square meal viz. Breakfast, Lunch, Evening Snacks and Dinner. There are special meals and celebrations, on festive occasions for students of all castes and religions. ADMISSION PROCESS

WE REQUEST ALL TO FOLLOW THE FOLLOWING PROCEDURE FOR ADMISSION:

1. **REGISTRATION** : Registration forms are available at the school during office hours and can also be downloaded from our website. The registration form should be duly filled and the completed form is to be submitted in the school office during office hours or by e-mail.
2. **ADMISSION TEST** : Admission test is a must, irrespective of whether there is vacancy in a particular class or not. For limited seats, the admission shall be granted on the basis of the performance in the admission test on merit basis. Please note that performance in the admission test helps us understand the child in various aspects and helps us in counselling and grooming the child accordingly.
3. **INDIVIDUAL SESSION WITH THE PRINCIPAL** : Following the admission test, the Dean/Principal of the School shall meet each candidate individually along with respective parents/guardian to discuss important aspects of the child's admission.
4. **INTERACTION OF THE PARENTS WITH THE PRINCIPAL** : Interaction of the parents with the Dean/Principal shall be done at the same time while the student is writing his/her Admission Test.
5. **ADMISSION FORMS** : Once steps 1 to 4 is complete, the parents are requested to duly fill the admission form and submit the same along with relevant documents as required by the school.
